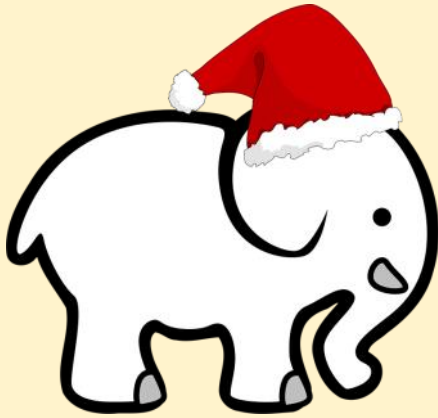

January 17th Annual Kick Off Breakfast

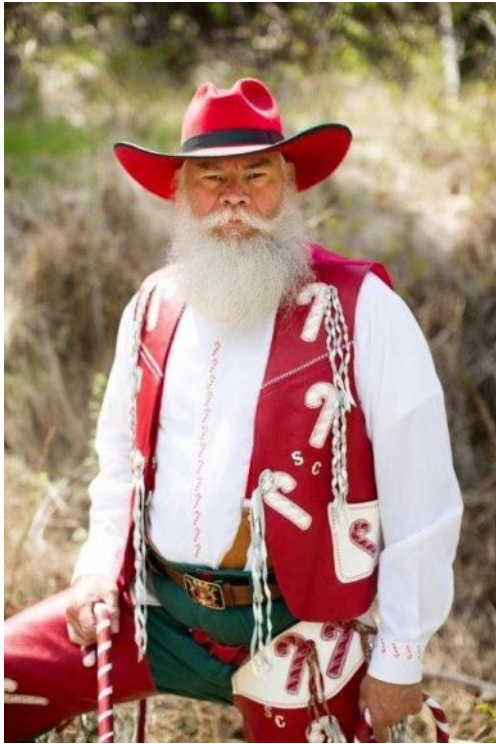

The club is underwriting the balance including room, tax and gratuity

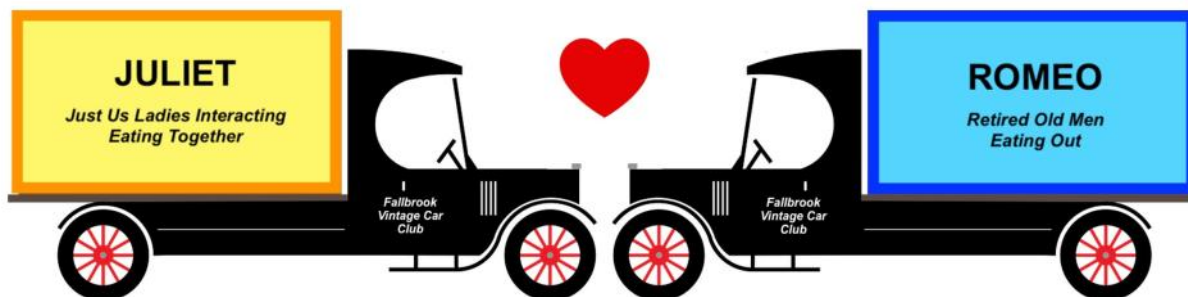
